

Institutional Policy of Universidad Nacional de La Plata – UNLP

1. Health insurance is an essential and unavoidable character for the foreign student's acceptance in our university.

Before leaving their country of origin, the student will contract the international health insurance which will have to contain at least the following requirements:

- Cover the medical-hospital services and of emergency in the country.
- Have accidental death coverage.
- Permanent and parcial disability.
- Medical-pharmaceutical attendance.
- Repatriation.
- Travel assistance.

2. The student shall assume the insurance cost.

3. It is also an Essentials requirement for the student's admission the psychophysical aptitude certificate sended out by a public entity.

4. In the case of those students who can apply for a visa in Argentina, they will have 30 working days to obtain it.

5. The student shall assume the cost of the migration fee.

6. On arrival to the country, the student should contact the Consulate or Embassy of Origin.

7. If the student travels to other places in Argentina, he/she should inform, 5 days before, to the Department of International University Relations the date and destination of the trip.

8. If the student travels abroad, he/she should inform the Department of International University Relations and the respective Consulate, 5 days in advance.

9. The UNLP shall not be held liable for the student's good health and physical condition, nor for any trouble that may eventually arise while being abroad.

10. The student shall comply with the course attendance regulations prescribed by the School of Choice.

11. This University will only send out study's certifications to those students who have, depending on the case, the temporary or provisional, residence visa. The UNLP does not issue any academic school transcripts to students with a tourist visa.

12. The UNLP grading system is as follows:

10	Outstanding
8, 9	Very Good
6, 7	Good
4, 5	Satisfactory
1, 2, 3	Below Standard

13. Student's signature accepting the UNLP institutional politics is an essential and unavoidable requirement for the student acceptance by this University.

Failure to fulfill any of the clauses above shall mean the return of the student to the country of origin.

Note: for a successful stay at the UNLP, it is suggested to comply with the Argentine socio-cultural habits and traditions, obeying the basic rules of living together and citizenship. In case a controversy on this matter appears, the UNLP may, provided it is deemed appropriate, advice the University of origin of the student, to discontinue his/her stay at the UNLP
